Bell Articulated Mine Haul Truck Fire

A mine's articulated haul truck caught fire whilst travelling with load along the haul road of the mine. The operator attempted to extinguish the fire with a fire extinguisher, but the fire overpowered and engulfed the truck.

The truck operator and other persons at risk of fire were safely evacuated.

INITIAL OBSERVATIONS:

- Engine oil leaked and contacted the hot component of the truck's engine.
- Overloading of an aging mobile equipment.
- Aging equipment kept in operations without proper fire suppression systems onboard.
- Inadequate and improper mobile equipment maintenance system.
- Incompetent maintenance personnel.
- Incompetent equipment operator.
- Failure to use OEM recommended spare parts on the trucks.
- Lack of leadership and supervision at equipment maintenance.
